



Central Division SCCA is looking to entice participation at the CenDiv Double Divisional at Blackhawk Farms Raceway in Rockton, Illinois the weekend of April 13-14, 2019.

To accomplish this, we will be giving away one or more entries to (drivers choice) the 2019 ARRC (American Road Race of Champions held at Road Atlanta) or the 2019 Runoffs (at VIRginia International Raceway) if the entry count meets defined levels.

Divisional Entries are for each unique driver and class per day. Each entry (unique driver/class/day) will have a chance to win.

- Drivers who enter both days of the Divisionals will count as two entries and will have two chances to win.
- Drivers who enter two classes for both days of the Divisionals will count as four entries and will have four chances to win.

The winners will be announced on Sunday, April 14, 2019, toward the end of lunch. Additional names will be drawn in case the winner is unable or unwilling to attend the Runoffs or the ARRC event.

The cut-off date by which the winner must declare attendance at the Runoffs or the ARRC is August 31, 2019. Details for the declaration communication process will be provided to the winner.

If a primary winner declares they will not be attending the Runoffs nor the ARRC, then the offer will be tendered to the next name drawn and that driver will have 72 hours to respond as to their intent.

The winner cannot have any type of penalty assessed on them at the event (Runoffs / ARRC) as they are representatives of the Division.

In addition, one driver will be selected to receive a **\$375 cash award** to defray entry and other costs. Another driver will be selected to receive a **\$100 cash award**. It is the hope of our CenDiv Championship Series sponsors that these cash awards will encourage additional drivers to attend our local events.

New for 2019: Each regional race finish this weekend will be awarded double points. For participation, each race is a single race (one race Saturday and one race Sunday). For points, each race will be treated as 2 races, 1st place on Saturday will be awarded 25 points and 25 points. 1st place on Sunday will be awarded 25 points and 25 points. **There will be no bonus points for racing at this track for this event weekend.**
