Dear Race Chairs:

Prior to the start of each of the eleven CENDIV Series events you will receive a check in the amount of \$450 from the CENDIV Treasurer to cover the cash awards.

Instructions for Cash Awards, to be given, on Saturday evening, or end of day of first day of races, at the Social Event:

- Select winners. You will need to pick one (1) Driver and eight (8) Worker Volunteers. **It's very important to keep track of the names of the winners.**
- Read the preamble to the assembled group
- The awards are presented using the following format:
 - Seven (7) Volunteers; at each of the eleven Championship events, seven worker names will be drawn, by the Race Chairman, at random to receive a \$50 cash award from our sponsors. Worker need not be present.
 - One (1) Driver entered as of Saturday, at each of the eight (8) Divisional (regional) Championship events (excluding Majors) or an eighth worker volunteer. **Driver needs to be present. If not, draw an eighth worker volunteer for a \$50 cash award** and return the \$50 balance to the CENDIV Treasurer.
- **Post-event: forward a list of winners to CENDIV web master and to the CENDIV Treasurer.**

Please announce this as a preamble to the cash drawings:

With the 2020 season beginning this April at Blackhawk Farms and ending with the event in September at the Autobahn Country Club, CENDIV is hosting a total of eleven race weekends during the season. There are 19 points opportunity races spread across those weekends counting toward the series points. Eight Double Divisional Championship Series weekends and three Northern Conference US Majors Tour event weekends, comprise the CENDIV Divisional Championship Series for 2020. The series welcomes over 40 national and regional classed cars and an additional 13 CENDIV regionally classed cars to participate.

Over the past several years we have enjoyed and continue to enjoy the fortune of having two sponsors to the CENDIV road racing series; **TRO Manufacturing and C&P Installations**, both of whom have a long family tradition in the club and currently participate in road racing.

The intent of the Championship Series, and our sponsors Scott and Chris, is to support and build the Divisional racing program. To those ends, there are no extra fees in the entrant's entry for the Divisional Series races, and only a small fee is collected from the Major's events to fund the 2020 CENDIV Divisional Championship Series.

Sponsorship from TRO Manufacturing and C&P Installations goes directly into the series to fund cash awards for workers and drivers. The sponsorship also funds graphics for the cars, class event winner stickers and year end trophies.
